CBMS is partnering with RMC Research to administer the 2025 National Survey of Undergraduate Mathematical Sciences Programs.

The National Survey of Undergraduate Mathematical Sciences Programs is an NSF-funded survey conducted every five years to gather information about common practices and emerging trends of undergraduate mathematics and statistics education in the United States. For the 2025 administration, CBMS is partnering with RMC Research to survey a stratified random sample of U.S. departments in the mathematical sciences across two-year and four-year institutions.

Along with CBMS and RMC, the CBMS 2025 National Survey is in collaboration with the American Mathematical Society, the American Statistical Association, the American Mathematical Association of Two-Year Colleges. The presidents of each mathematical sciences organization have endorsed this survey and strongly encourage participation.
