### Physics Decided That "The Time is Now"

#### **Timeline**

- In 2020, AIP wrote a Landscape paper called the "The Time is Now"
- This paper has several bold recommendations, one of which was a \$50M endowment to generate \$2.5M in yearly revenue
- In 2022, Michael Maloney, CEO of AIP met with Simons and used this document to make the case.
- Were Funded for \$12.5M
